2018 Achievement and Service Awards: Congratulations to Dr. Naji Abumrad!

Message from Dr. Haytham Kaafarani, AUB-SAANA President, introducing the recipient of the 2018 Awards:

Thank you for everyone who voted this year - your engagement was extremely appreciated. All the names that were suggested during the voting process were those of very impressive surgeons, and it gives everyone great pride to see how many people in our society are deserving. Based on the voting counts, It gives us exceptional pleasure to announce that **Dr. Naji Abumrad is the recipient of both the Academic Achievement as well as the Service Awards** for this year.

Dr. Abumrad is currently the John L. Sawyer Professor of Surgery at Vanderbilt. He graduated from AUB in 1971 and is solidly recognized as one of the giants of surgery in North America with an impressive record of leadership and academic/research roles at SUNY, Vanderbilt and nationally (e.g. NIH). His research contributions in understanding metabolic and endocrine surgery, especially the impact of obesity and bariatric surgery on diabetes, are innumerable: more than 250 peer-reviewed editorials, articles and textbook chapters, some in the highest impact journals such as Nature, JAMA, and the Annals of Surgery.

As importantly, Dr. Abumrad has helped hundreds of AUB graduates find their careers all over the world, especially in the US. I have not met Naji personally yet (looking forward to meeting him soon), but I keep hearing, from many of his AUBite and non-AUBite colleagues, praise about his consistent selflessness and dedication to mentoring and helping others.

<u>Please join us in congratulating Naji</u> for his well-deserved awards, and do every effort to join us in celebrating him in person next October at the Annual Reception in Boston. # **AUBMC Department of Surgery updates, April 2018**

#### **NEW FACULTY:**

The Department of Surgery is pleased to announce that three additional faculty members have joined the department this past Academic Year, bringing the total number of faculty to 63 members (including 3 emeritus professors).

## Please join us in welcoming our three newest faculty members:

**Dr. Ahmad Zaghal**: Instructor of Clinical Surgery, Division of General Surgery, Pediatric Surgery Section, joined AUBMC in September 2017. Dr Zaghal received his training in General Surgery at AUBMC followed by a 2-year Pediatric Surgery fellowship at the University of Iowa and One year of additional pediatric Surgery training at the Chelsea and Westminster Hospital, NHS Trust.

**Dr Jamil Borgi**: Assistant Professor of Clinical Surgery, Division of Cardio-Thoracic Surgery joined AUBMC in January 2018. Dr Borgi received his General Surgery training at Henry Ford Hospital, followed by a Cardio-Thoracic Surgery Fellowship at the University of Washington. He was then recruited back to Henry Ford where he was concentrating his practice on complex adult cardiac surgery with a focus on aortic disease and heart failure, heart and lung transplantation.

**Dr Houssein Darwish:** Instructor of Clinical Surgery, Division of Neurosurgery, joined AUBMC in March 2018. He completed his Neurosurgery training at AUBMC followed by an Endoscopic, Neuroendocrine and Skull base fellowship at the University of Virginia. After practicing for two years at Bahman and Khoury BMG hospitals he obtained additional training in stereotactic Neurosurgery and Deep brain Stimulation at the Cleveland Clinic, Florida.
